The RSCA Board of Directors consists of 12 members. RSCA Bylaws permit one-third of the Directors to be elected each year for a three-year term. Provided that votes are cast by a least 10% of the Members, the four individuals receiving the most votes will be elected to the Board for a three-year term beginning January 1, 2012.
